Safe School Environment and Violence Prevention Activities

- Install Security Cameras at CISD Secondary Campuses
- Employ a trained staff member to monitor the Video Cameras for security purposes
- **Olweus Bullying Prevention Program** at all CISD Elementary Schools through *Communities In Schools*
- In-home family preservation /counseling services for students involved with *Juvenile Probation*

Alcohol, Tobacco, and Other Drugs Prevention Activities

- **Lifeskills Training Curriculum** in all 6 – 8 grade campuses in the district presented by CISD's *Prevention Education Specialists*
- Utilize the **Parenting Wisely** curriculum for parent education and involvement

Student Behavioral, Social and Emotional Supports

- Increase the services provided by the CISD's **DARE** Program *Comal and Bexar County Sheriff's Office*
- Provide additional **ESL & GED** Classes to Comal ISD residents *Comal/ Guadalupe/Kendall County Adult Ed.*

Mental Health Services

- Provide 3 Licensed Mental Health counselors to offer school-based Mental Health Services through *Hill Country Community MHMR*
- Screening and Assessments of school-aged children referred for Mental Health Services
- Art, Music, Recreational Therapies and Family Counseling / Parenting Skills with *Connections*
- Case-Management of Students referred for Mental Health and other services by *CISD Case Managers*
