No Child Left Behind

NCLB

The purpose of the Comal ISD's No Child Left Behind (NCLB) program is to enable every child in the school district to fulfill his/her academic potential and perform at or above grade level on state and local assessments, kindergarten through 12th grade.

This program coordinates funding from federal, state and local sources to provide supplemental services to students who meet state or local at-risk eligibility criteria.

These criteria include evidence of performance below grade level in foundation curriculum areas such as mathematics and language arts, limited English proficiency, and/or other factors that may negatively affect a student's ability to succeed academically.

Supplemental Services

The following services are provided through the NCLB program:

- Individualized instruction within a classroom setting
- Specialized reading, writing and/or math programs
- Educational enrichment activities
- Individualized computer-assisted instruction
- Mentorship and/or counseling
- Parenting programs
- TAKS remediation opportunities
- Tutorials
- Reduced class size

At-Risk Students

Once a student is retained, or not advanced from one grade level to the next, the student remains at-risk for the remainder of his/her public school education. For all other state eligibility criteria, students must be evaluated on an ongoing basis to determine if they continue to meet the criteria for being at-risk. Under certain criteria, students will be reported for one or more school years until the student performs at a level of sufficiency to exit the at-risk special population category.
