REGISTRATION Information

Updated June 28, 2011

New students may register at any time during the school year. For students entering the district during summer months, registration is held by each school in August, generally a few weeks before school starts. For August registration and back-to-school information, go to www.comalisd.org, call the school or call the district at (830) 221-2000.

Bring to registration:

- two documents showing proof of residency,
- immunization record from doctor or previous school,
- unofficial transcript or last report card,
- birth certificate,
- social security number (optional), and
- custody papers, if applicable

Immunization Requirements

Specific information regarding immunizations can be obtained from the school nurse or the Texas Department of State Health Services. Students entering CISD schools must be current on all of the following immunizations:

- Polio: 4 doses of polio; one must be received on or after the 4th birthday.
- DTP/DTaP/Tdap: 5 doses with last dose on or after 4th birthday, or 4 doses if 4th was on or after 4th birthday; 1 booster Tdap prior to starting 7th grade, or 5 years after last Tdap; and for 8th-12th grades, 1 booster Tdap 10 years after last Tdap
- Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR): 2 doses, 1st on or after 1st birthday and 2nd by age 5 or prior to kindergarten enrollment
- Hepatitis B: 3 doses prior to kindergarten enrollment
- Varicella (Chickenpox): 2 doses with 1st dose on or after 1st birthday, prior to kindergarten and 7th grade enrollment; 1st-6th and 8th-12th grades require one dose
- Hepatitis A: 2 doses with 1st dose on or after 1st birthday, prior to kindergarten enrollment; 1 dose required for 1st-12th grades; SES and TPES attendance zones require 2 doses for all grades
- Meningococcal: 1 dose prior to 7th grade enrollment
- Tb Skin Test: new students must have either a past Tb Skin Test with validated reading OR a completed Tuberculosis Screening Form (a Tb Skin Test may be required depending on answers to the form)

All students enrolling in the CISD for the first time, including pre-kindergarten, kindergarten, and transfer students, must show that a tuberculosis test was completed a year prior to entry.

Free and Reduced-priced Meals

The CISD provided free and reduced-priced meals for students under the National School Lunch Program and the School Breakfast Program. Household size and income are used to determine eligibility for free and reduced-priced meals. To apply for the free and reduced-priced meals, households must complete an application, available at any CISD school or at the Support Services Building, and return it to the school any time during the year.

Pre-kindergarten

CISD offers pre-kindergarten in half-day sessions, with the exception of two full-day sessions with limited space. To be eligible for the pre-kindergarten program, a child must turn four years old in or before Sept. 1 and must:

- meet limited English proficiency qualifications, OR
- be homeless, OR
- be in, or have been in, Texas Department of Family and Protective Services’ foster care or other residential care, OR
- be a child of an active duty member of the armed forces or a child of an armed forces member injured or killed while on active duty.

*Documentation is required to determine if the child is eligible for pre-kindergarten. A Free/Reduced Lunch application must be completed in August for the year during which the student will attend pre-kindergarten.

Morning and afternoon buses are available on established routes and at normally scheduled times. Specific transportation arrangements will be made for each child at the school campus. Mid-day transportation must be arranged by the parent.

Kindergarten

The CISD has all-day kindergarten classes. Children must be 5 years old on or before September 1st of that school year to be eligible for kindergarten. Bus transportation to and from school is available on established routes and times. For more information about the kindergarten program, contact the elementary school.

Delay of school due to bad weather

If weather conditions or other emergencies prevent the opening of schools, the district may delay the start of school, cancel school, or release students early. For notices, watch San Antonio TV stations, listen to KGBN at 1420 AM, KNBT at 92.1 FM, WOAI at 1200 AM or KTSA at 550 AM, call any CISD school, or monitor the district’s website at www.comalisd.org. The district may use its automated telephone system to call parents with information. If school times are delayed, buses run approximately one hour later than the usual time.
