### **Brown appointed principal of Canyon High**

Brad Brown is the new principal of Canyon High School in the Comal ISD after the school board approved his appointment during tonight's meeting. His first day on the job as a Cougar will be July 23.

The public, including parents and staff, is invited to meet Brown and his family during a welcome reception this Monday, July 2, from 6 to 8 p.m. in the Canyon High library.

"I am extremely excited about joining the Canyon High School team," Brown says. "I look forward to working with the students, staff, and community to maintain Canyon's tradition of excellence."

Brown, who has 18 years experience in public education, has been principal of Pearland Junior High South, a "Recognized" school in the Pearland ISD near Houston, since 2003. He previously served as an associate principal and assistant principal of Clear Creek High School in the Clear Creek ISD from 1995 to 2003. Before joining Clear Creek he was a social studies teacher in Houston ISD and an assistant middle school principal.

"Brad's experiences as a secondary classroom teacher and administrator at the middle and high school levels will benefit the Canyon community," says Dr. Marc Walker, superintendent. "He is a proven communicator and leader and will help us take Canyon High to the next level."

Brown's bachelor's degree in secondary education is from the University of Southern Indiana. His master's degree and mid-management certification is from the University of Houston-Clear Lake.

He takes over the reins from Bob Wiegand who retired at the end of the school year after leading the campus for eight years.
