Two Canyon High softball players sign with Big 12 Conference schools

Two of the players that helped lead the Canyon High softball team to the state tournament the past two seasons are headed to the Big 12 Conference.

Sarah Crockett signed a national letter of intent to play at Baylor University and Sara Mireles signed with Texas



A&M in a ceremony at CHS on Nov. 10. Both are seniors this year.

They were starters on Canyon High's 2009 UIL Class 4A State Championship team.

"These two players have certainly been a big part of what we've accomplished the last couple of years," said CHS head coach Kevin Randle. "I'm just glad we have them back for another season. It's very rewarding to know they will be able to continue their playing careers at great universities."

Crockett was a designated hitter/first baseman last year and will be a catcher/first baseman this year. The All-Region selection hit .382 with 34 RBI and five home runs.

Mireles, who was named All-State after both her sophomore and junior seasons, has a combined pitching of 63-7 record over the last two years. She has struck out an amazing 536 batters and has a miniscule 0.73 earned run average during that timeframe.
