Two Comal ISD campuses to be dedicated on Oct.18

Comal ISD will dedicate its two newest campuses, Johnson Ranch and Oak Creek elementary schools, on Sunday, Oct. 18.

Johnson Ranch Elementary will hold its dedication at 1 p.m. This beautifully designed new school is located at 30501 Johnson Way in Bulverde at the former Clyde Johnson & Sons Ranch. It was built to relieve overcrowding at Specht and Rahe Bulverde elementary schools. The project cost \$14.6 million. The architect was Pfluger & Associates, and the contractor was FT Woods.

Oak Creek Elementary School's dedication will start at 4 p.m. Located at 3060 Goodwin Lane in New Braunfels, this campus is alleviating overcrowding at Hoffmann Lane and Goodwin Frazier elementary schools. The project cost \$17.3 million. The architect was SHW Group, and the contractor was Baird/Williams Construction.

The \$189 million Bond 2005 issue financed both schools, and the debt service portion of the tax rate used to pay back the bonds has actually decreased by three cents.

Each dedication is open to the public. Refreshments will be available.

"We're looking for a big turnout at both dedications," Comal ISD superintendent Dr. Marc Walker said. "So much went into the planning and building of these schools, and it's wonderful to see so many of our students enjoying their time at these campuses."
