

Both the history-making Canyon and Smithson Valley high school softball state championship teams were presented a plaque, which included team photos and congratulatory remarks from the school board at the June 24 meeting at the Comal ISD Support Services Building.

On June 6, CHS won the second-ever team title in the school's 50-year history with a 4-2 victory over Angleton, which gave the squad the Class 4A crown. The Cougarettes, led by head coach Kevin Randle, finished with a 38-3 record after winning their final 20 games. Later that same day, the SVHS Rangers captured their second state softball title this decade by winning the 5A championship game 1-0 against Pearland. Head coach Wayne Daigle's team won its final 21 games and finished with a 30-5 record. It marked the first time in UIL history two teams from the same district won state softball titles in the same year.
