Graduation ceremonies a success in Comal ISD

Comal Independent School District graduated more than 1,100 seniors this year during graduation week, May 25 – 29.

Memorial High School, the district's self-paced campus, started the pomp and circumstance on May 25 at the New Braunfels Civic Center. At that time, 59 seniors received their diplomas.

May 29 was the big day as Canyon, Canyon Lake and Smithson Valley high schools conducted graduation ceremonies at Strahan Coliseum at Texas State University in San Marcos.

Between Canyon, Canyon Lake and Smithson Valley high school seniors, more than \$8 million in college and local scholarships were awarded to this year's graduates. Of that amount, about \$300,000 came from local organizations, companies, and associations.
