### **Almost 1,100 graduates in Comal ISD this year**

Comal Independent School District is graduating nearly 1,100 seniors this year during “graduation week,” May 26 – 30.

Between Canyon and Smithson Valley high school seniors, more than \$7.1 million in college and local scholarships are being awarded to this year’s graduates. Of that amount, about \$225,000 comes from local organizations, companies, and associations.

Memorial High School, the district’s self-paced campus, will start the pomp and circumstance on Tuesday, May 26, at 7 p.m., in the New Braunfels Civic Center. At that time, about 55 seniors from throughout Comal County will receive their diplomas.

On Wednesday, May 27, Canyon Lake High, which will not have a full class of seniors until next school year, will have a ceremony to honor its first four graduates. It will take place at the school’s auditorium, beginning at 7 p.m.

Saturday, May 30 is the big day as both Canyon and Smithson Valley high schools conduct their graduation ceremonies in the Strahan Coliseum at Texas State University — San Marcos.

The Canyon High ceremony is at 9 a.m. and about 400 seniors will cross the stage. Smithson Valley High’s ceremony is at 2 p.m. and about 630 seniors will receive their diplomas then.

It will be the largest-ever graduating class at both Canyon and Smithson Valley high schools.
