Comal ISD performs at high levels on TAKS

The preliminary results are in and Comal ISD students continue to excel on the annual Texas Assessment of Knowledge and Skills (TAKS) tests.

“We are pleased with the results,” said Dr. Marc Walker, superintendent. “Our teachers and students continue to excel and go above and beyond the state TEKS (Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills) curriculum which gives our students an extra advantage on the test.”

When all grade levels taking a test are summed together, the following are the preliminary accountability results for each content area.

- **Social Studies** — 98 percent passed
- **Science** — 92 percent passed
- **Reading/English Language Arts** — 94 percent passed
- **Math** — 90 percent passed
- **Writing** — 95 percent passed

The percentage of Comal ISD students reaching the commended level continues to improve as well. To be commended, students could not miss more than a few questions on a test (the number varies by test).

In social studies, 60 percent of all students reached the commended level. In reading and science, 42 percent of all students were at the commended level, and in math 33 percent of students earned commended status.

Official district and individual school ratings will be released by the Texas Education Agency (TEA) later this summer. In 2010, Comal ISD was a TEA “Recognized” district.
