Miller appointed to fill vacancy on school board

Carolyn Miller, an executive assistant in the department of Human Ecology at The University of Texas at Austin, is the newest member of the Comal ISD's board of trustees. The board appointed Miller to fill the vacancy left by Laura Kistner in late May when she had to resign because she moved outside of her board member district.

Miller was unanimously approved by the board and sworn in during the board's July 24 regular meeting. She will represent single-member district 1 which encompasses the part of Comal ISD located in New Braunfels and east toward Seguin off of Hwy. 46. In May, during the regular school board elections, she will have to run for the remaining year on the three-year term.

Miller and her husband, Marcus, have three children and the youngest attends Canyon High School. She attended Texas A&M University and has worked for UT for a total of 27 years.
