It's time to register 4- and 5-year-olds for prekinder and kindergarten

The Comal Independent School District will be registering 4- and 5-year-olds for 2008-2009 prekindergarten and kindergarten classes the weeks of March 10 and March 24, according to the schedule below. In addition, students new to the Comal ISD in grades Pk-5th can register early at Bill Brown and Rahe Bulverde elementary schools.

Arlon Seay Elementary (830-885-1250) — PreK/K only:
March 25 and 27, 9-11 a.m. and 1-2 p.m.;
March 26, 9-11 a.m. and 1-6:30 p.m.

Bill Brown Elementary (830-885-1400) — March 25 and 26, 8:30 a.m. to 2 p.m.; March 27, 8:30 a.m. to 6:30 p.m.
* This is for new students only at all grade levels (Pk-5th)

Comal and Morningside Elementary (830-221-2250) — PreK/K only:
(Both held at Comal Elementary) March 11, 5:30 p.m.
* After March 11, you can register Monday-Friday 9 a.m.-2 p.m., for the rest of the school year

Freiheit Elementary (830-221-2700) — PreK/K only:
March 12, 2 to 4 p.m.; March 13, 2 to 6 p.m.

Goodwin Frazier Elementary (830-221-2200) — PreK/K only:
March 10, 2 to 4 p.m.; March 11, 2 to 6 p.m.

Hoffmann Lane Elementary (830-221-2500) — PreK/K only:
March 27, 6:30-8 p.m.

Rahe Bulverde Elementary (830-885-1600) —
March 11 and 12, 9 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.; March 13, 9 a.m. to 6 p.m.
*For new students only at all grade levels (PreK/5th)

Rebecca Creek Elementary (830-885-1450) — PreK/K only:

March 25 and April 1, 8 a.m. to 7 p.m.

Specht and Timberwood Park Elementary (830-885-1500) —
March 11 and 12, 9-11 a.m. and 1-2:30 p.m.;
March 13, 9-11 a.m. and 1-6:30 p.m.

Startzville Elementary (830-885-8000) — PreK/K only:
March 25, 7 a.m. to noon; March 26, noon to 7 p.m.

To qualify for kindergarten, a child must be 5-years-old on or before Sept. 1 (state law).

To be eligible for prekindergarten, a child must meet the following requirements (federal law): Turn 4-years-old on or before Sept. 1 AND meet federal income requirements OR meet limited English proficiency qualifications OR be homeless OR be a child of an active duty member of the armed forces or a child of an armed forces member injured or killed while on active duty.

Parents need to bring their child, copies of proof of income (if applicable), child's birth certificate, social security number (optional), up-to-date immunization records, and two documents showing proof of residency. Documentation is required to determine if the child is eligible for prekindergarten. A current Free or Reduced Lunch application (if applicable) must be completed in August for the year in which the student will attend prekindergarten.

If parents have a child with special needs, be aware that services become available on his/her 3rd birthday. Contact the school or the Special Education Department at 830-221-2088 / 830-885-1791 / 830-609-6280.
