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CISD provides services to children with special needs; screening Sept. 18

The Comal Independent School District provides services to students with special needs.

Comal ISD will be conducting an Early Childhood Screening at Bill Brown Elementary School (20410 Hwy 46 West, Spring Branch). The screening will take place Thursday, Sept. 18, from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., and will be provided at no charge.

This free appropriate public education is offered to eligible children ages 3 through 21, who may have one of the following disabilities: learning disabilities, speech or language impairment, orthopedic or health impairment, emotional disturbance, mental retardation, autism, traumatic brain injury, other health impairment or multiple disabilities. Services for children who are deaf-blind, or have a visual or auditory impairment, may begin at birth.

If you think that you know a child ranging in age from birth to 5 years-old who may have speech, language, or developmental delays, and resides in the Comal ISD attendance zone, please call Pat Hermes at (830) 221-2042 to schedule an appointment for a free screening.

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
