Two principal appointments announced

Two elementary principal appointments were announced this week by Dr. Marc Walker, Comal ISD superintendent.

Oak Creek Elementary, one of the district's newest schools opening this August in New Braunfels, will be led by Lyndon Langford, the principal of Goodwin Frazier Elementary since 2007. As a result, Cheryl Lucas, Freiheit Elementary's assistant principal, will become Goodwin Frazier's new principal this August.

Langford has been in public education since 1974. Prior to joining Comal, he was an administrator in the Apple Springs, Austin, and Pflugerville school districts. His degrees are from Stephen F. Austin University.

Prior to arriving in Comal ISD in 1997, Lucas was a teacher in the Marion school district for five years. She has been a prekindergarten teacher at Goodwin Primary, a district instructional coordinator, and has been an assistant principal since 2005 at Goodwin Frazier and now Freiheit Elementary School. Her degrees are from the University of Texas at Austin and Southwest Texas State University (now Texas State University).

Oak Creek Elementary will open to approximately 550 students in prekindergarten through 5th grade. The school is located on Goodwin Lane and is being built from Bond 2005 proceeds. Students from Hoffmann Lane and Goodwin Frazier elementary schools will be attending Oak Creek. -CISD-
