Comal ISD provides services to children with special needs; screenings Feb. 26

The Comal Independent School District provides services to students with special needs.

This free appropriate public education is offered to eligible children ages 3 through 21, who may have one of the following disabilities: learning disabilities, speech or language impairment, orthopedic or health impairment, emotional disturbance, mental retardation, autism, traumatic brain injury, other health impairment or multiple disabilities. Services for children who are deaf-blind, or have a visual or auditory impairment, may begin at birth.

Comal ISD will be conducting Early Childhood Screenings at Bill Brown, Goodwin Frazier, Rebecca Creek and Morningside elementary schools. The screenings will take place Thursday, Feb. 26, from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., and will be provided at no charge.
