Three Comal ISD campuses to be dedicated

The Comal ISD will soon dedicate its three newest campuses — Morningside Elementary, Mountain Valley Middle and Timberwood Park Elementary.

Morningside Elementary will hold its dedication on Sunday, Oct. 19, beginning at 2 p.m. This beautifully designed new school is located at 3855 Morningside Dr., in New Braunfels. It was built to relieve overcrowding at Comal Elementary. The project cost \$14.5 million. The architect was SHW, and the contractor was Drymalla Construction.

Timberwood Park Elementary will have its dedication on Sunday, Oct. 26, starting at 2 p.m. Located at 26715 S. Glenrose in San Antonio, this two-story campus was built in a scenic part of Northern Bexar County. It helped alleviate overcrowding at Specht Elementary. The project cost \$14 million. The architect was Pfluger Associates, and the contractor was Drymalla Construction.

Mountain Valley Middle's dedication is scheduled for Sunday, Nov. 9, beginning at 2 p.m. It is the former Mountain Valley School, which used to house grades K-5. Located at 1165 Sattler Rd., in Sattler, this newly renovated campus, which feeds into Canyon Lake High, is now home to grades 6-8. The renovation cost \$12.4 million. The project's architect was Pfluger Associates, and the contractor was Kencon.

The \$189 million Bond 2005 issue financed all three schools, and the debt service portion of the tax rate used to pay back the bonds has actually decreased by three cents.

Each dedication is open to the public. Refreshments will be available.

“We’re looking for a big turnout at all three dedications,” Comal ISD superintendent Dr. Marc Walker said. “So much went into the planning and building of these schools, and it’s wonderful to see so many of our students enjoying their time at these campuses.”
