## Veterans Day Programs

### **Bill Brown Elementary: Monday, November 12, at 9 am**

Members of the SVHS choir will join the 4th grade choir and student body in honoring veterans and active military members. The ceremony will be held on the blacktop behind the school (weather permitting) and should last about one hour.
