Comal ISD schedules mandatory parent meetings for new dual language program for kindergarteners

For the 2010-11 school year, Clear Spring Elementary, Morningside Elementary and Bill Brown Elementary will offer a Dual Language Program for all students entering kindergarten in Comal ISD.

Comal ISD will hold three mandatory meetings for parents interested in enrolling their child in the Dual Language Program. The first meeting will be held at Freiheit Elementary on Wednesday, March 3 at 6:30 p.m. The other two meetings will take place at Bill Brown Elementary on Tuesday, March 30 at 6:30 p.m. and at Morningside Elementary on Tuesday, April 13 at 6:30 p.m.

Students registered for the new program will be fluent in both the Spanish and English languages by the end of the program and are expected to achieve as well or better in all other academic areas.

Because one of the goals of the program is to become bilingual and bi-literate, the students admitted into the program will be required to participate until the fifth grade. Both native English speaking and native Spanish speaking students are invited to register to be a part of this exciting program.
