### **Two Comal ISD school board seats up for election**

The annual Comal ISD board of trustees' election will be held Saturday, May 8. Candidates interested in filing for one of the two seats up for election can start doing so Monday, Feb. 8. The deadline to file is Monday, March 8.

Comal ISD is divided into seven single-member districts (SMD), each represented by a member of the board of trustees who serves a three-year term. For 2010, only single-member districts six and seven are up for election.

Currently representing SMD 6 is David Spencer who has served on the board since his election in 2007. His area covers mostly Bexar County and a portion of Comal County.

SMD 7, represented by Bill Swint, is the second seat up for election this year. Swint has been a Comal ISD board member for seven years. His area includes mostly Comal County in the Garden Ridge area and a portion of Guadalupe County.

People interested in filing for one of the seats must be registered voters, live in the SMD they are filing for, and have been residents of Comal ISD for six months. Voter registration cards tell each patron their SMD number.

**DISTRICT SIX:** Begin at the intersection of State Highway 46 and the Comal/Kendall County line, also being the Comal ISD boundary. Go southeast on State Highway 46, south on Bulverde Road, east on Bulverde Road, south on U.S. Highway 281, east/north/east/south along Cibolo Creek, then west/north around the school district territory located in Bexar County. Go west along Cibolo Creek, also being the school

district boundary, and north/northeast on the Comal/Kendall County line back to the point of origin with State Highway 46.

**DISTRICT SEVEN:** Begin at the intersection of Smithson Valley Road and State Highway 46. Go southeast on State Highway 46 to the Comal ISD boundary. Follow the school district boundary around the southwest portion of the school district territory located in Guadalupe County. Then follow Cibolo Creek northwest/northeast to Farm-to-Market Road 1863. Go west on Farm-to-Market Road 1863, north then west around Oak Village North limits, then northeast on Smithson Valley Road back to the point of origin with State Highway 46.
