### **Comal ISD gifted/talented informational parent meetings to be held Sept. 28, 29**

Comal ISD parents interested in the district's Gifted/Talented program are invited to attend one of two meetings on Sept. 28 or 29 to learn more about the program, who it serves, what services are offered and much more.

The Sept. 28 meeting will be held from 6:30-7:30 p.m. in the board room of the district's Support Services Building located at 1404 IH 35 North in New Braunfels. The Sept. 29 meeting will take place from 6:30-7:30 p.m. in the Smithson Valley Middle School cafeteria located at 6101 FM 311 in Spring Branch.

"These meetings will allow Comal ISD parents whose children are newly identified as gifted/talented to learn more about our GT program and what can be expected," said Comal ISD's advanced academics coordinator Teri Moore. "It will also give me the opportunity to meet our parents since I am new to the district. I encourage all of our GT parents to attend if they are new to the program."

In addition to being introduced to the GT program and staff, parents can also expect to learn more about how the instruction is differentiated for GT students at each grade level, how GT facilitators and teachers are trained, and what GT services are available at each grade level.

“Comal ISD’s GT program offers a carefully designed menu of services at each level of instruction,” Moore said. “Students who participate in the GT program receive differentiated instruction in the regular classroom setting, participate in twice weekly pull-out sessions at the elementary level, and have the opportunity to participate in special electives at the middle and high school levels. Parents will walk away from these meetings with more information about this, so we hope they will be able to join us.”

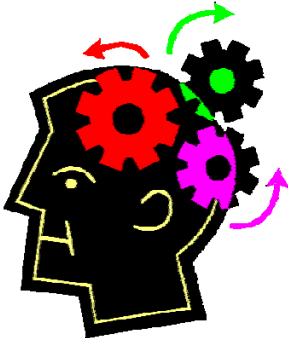
