Three new assistant principals welcomed to Comal ISD

Comal ISD is pleased to announce the appointment of three new assistant principals to the district.

Jodi Cox is the new assistant principal at Comal Elementary. She replaces Joni Coker who is now Comal's principal. Cox has been in public education since 1994 when she started as an elementary teacher in the Midland ISD. She most recently has been an assistant principal in the Irving ISD. Her bachelor's degree is from Texas Tech University and she has two master's degrees, one from Southern Methodist University and one from the University of Texas at Arlington.

Jon Lindholm is a new assistant principal at Canyon Lake High School after serving in the same capacity in the Marion ISD. Canyon Lake High is opening to freshmen and sophomores on Aug. 27. Previous to that he was a high school teacher in the North East ISD and has been in public education since 1995. Lindholm's degrees are from the University of Texas at Austin and Texas A&M University in Kingsville.

Richard Rathburn, a teacher at Smithson Valley High School since 1999, is Church Hill Middle School's new assistant principal. Church Hill, formerly Canyon Intermediate School, is the district's newest middle school. Rathburn holds a bachelor's degree from the University of Houston and is completing his master's degree through Texas State University
