Renovated RBES campus officially dedicated

Everyone had bright smiles on their faces on March 9, as the renovated Rahe Bulverde Elementary was officially dedicated.

The former Bulverde Elementary building was renovated thanks to funding from Bond 2005 and is now a two-story K-5th grade campus complete with new technology, larger classrooms, and upgrades to the library, cafeteria, theater and playground area.

Members of the Rahe family were present at the dedication ceremony. The ceremony also included a speaker, Alice Grosser Morris, who attended the original rock building Bulverde Rural High School, which opened in 1945. It later became Rahe Primary School.

Superintendent Dr. Marc Walker officially dedicated the campus.

A music program "Rock With the Dinosaurs," which was directed by teacher Ruth Berban closed out the ceremony. Karen Williams' art students decorated the stage, cafeteria, and hallways.

"It was a great success," RBES principal Merrie Fox said. "To see this beautifully renovated campus go from the planning stages to where we're at now is just amazing."
