Specht Elementary capped again in 2007-08; relief in sight in 2008-09

Specht Elementary School, located in the Lookout Canyon subdivision in the southwest portion of Comal ISD, opened in 2002 and from the beginning the school has been near or over capacity. Considerable growth in the area has led to a full school again this coming year.

As a result, the school is capped again for the 2007-08 school year. Relief is in sight, however, as Timberwood Park Elementary is under construction and should open in August 2008. When it does, both schools are anticipated to handle kindergarten through fifth grades.

Until that time though, families new to the Specht attendance zone need to know that the school is capped and their children need to be enrolled at Rahe Bulverde Elementary at 1781 Ammann Rd. in Bulverde. This even includes students living in The Estates of Lookout Canyon (apartment townhomes) located directly behind the school.

“It is always possible that currently enrolled students may withdraw before school starts,” says Dr. Marc Walker, superintendent. “If that happens, Specht personnel will refer to the waiting list for the respective grade levels affected and those parents will be notified.”

To register in a Comal ISD school the following documents must be provided — birth certificate, two proofs of residency, updated shot record, unofficial transcript or last report card, student’s social security number (optional), and custody parents, if required.
