### **Comal ISD trustee election early voting starts April 26, election day May 8**

Early voting for the annual Comal ISD Board of Trustees' election starts April 26 and will run through May 4. Election Day is May 8.

Because Single-Member District (SMD) 6 is an unopposed race, there will not be early voting for that position. Early voting for SMD 7 will be held at the Garden Ridge Municipal Complex located at 9400 Municipal Parkway in Garden Ridge on April 26, 27, 29, 30 and May 4 from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. and on April 28 and May 3 from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

On Election Day, patrons may vote at the Garden Ridge Municipal Complex and at Comal Elementary School located at 6720 FM 482 in New Braunfels from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

Incumbents for both SMD 6 and 7 filed for re-election.

Currently representing SMD 6 is David Spencer who has served on the board since his election in 2007. His area covers mostly Bexar County and a portion of Comal County. He is the president of Texas Intrepid Ventures, Inc. in San Antonio. Spencer is running unopposed.

Bill Swint, immediate past president of the board, represents SMD 7 and has served on the board for seven years. His area includes mostly Comal County in the Garden Ridge area and a portion of Guadalupe County. Swint is a sales representative for Western Paper Company in Texas. Swint's opponent for SMD 7 is Jeff Victor who is an engineer.

Applications for ballots for early voting by mail should be sent to Joy Streater, Office of the County Clerk, at 150 North Seguin, Room 101, New Braunfels, Texas 78130.

Applications for ballots by mail must be received no later than the close of business on April 30.
