

School is almost back in session and before the ring of the first bell, Comal ISD has a few reminders for its parents and students.

Registration will begin the week of Aug. 3. Every campus has scheduled different registration dates and times, which can be found by [clicking here](#). Other district registration requirements and fact sheets can be found at www.comalisd.org by following the Back-to-School Information link.

Immunization requirements have changed for the 2009-10 school year. It is imperative that each student receive the required immunizations in order to register for school. [Click here](#) for a list of immunization requirements for grades K-12. The Back-to-School Information link on the district website will also provide additional information on walk-in immunization clinics and other district health services information.

Another change for the 2009-10 school year is school meal prices. To help offset rising costs, the board recently approved a \$.05 increase for school breakfast meals and a \$.10 increase for school lunch meals for the new school year. The new prices are as follows: elementary lunch, \$2.20; secondary lunch, \$2.45. All breakfast meals will cost \$1.30.

This year, Comal ISD is opening two new elementary schools as part of the district's 2005 bond. Johnson Ranch Elementary, which was built on the former Clyde Johnson Ranch in Bulverde, will relieve overcrowding at Specht and Rahe Bulverde elementary schools. Oak Creek Elementary, located on Goodwin Lane in New Braunfels, was built to help alleviate overcrowding at Hoffman-Lane and Goodwin Frazier elementary schools.
