Letter From Our PTA President

Dear Roper Parents,

I would like to start off by saying Thank You to all of the Parents, Teachers, and Staff Members of JRES who helped out with our 1st Annual Ropers' Wonderland! I received numerous phone calls, emails, and Facebook messages, from surrounding schools who all wanted to know what Ropers' Wonderland was and how we came up with such a great day?! It seems that having a Holiday party that is exactly the same for all grades is an excellent idea. It also seems that having two Snow Slides in Bulverde, TX is an EXCELLENT idea too!!!

Thank you for all the 2nd Grade Family and Friends who came to last week's Seussical performance. The 2nd Graders did a great job with all of their narration, songs, and all of their Dr. Seuss artwork that was displayed in the Cafeteria. Thank you again to Ms. Davis and Ms. Baker for a wonderful program!

The PTA also held their General Meeting just prior to the 2nd Grade performance. We were able to vote on and approve the Financials and a Revised Budget for the remainder of this school year. One of the main items that I would like to again share, is the announcement to increase our monies for School Field Trips this year. As you all may remember, this is not something that PTA has been a part of in years past. However, due to no monies being allotted for School Field Trips this year, it was something that we made a top priority. Originally we had planned to give each grade level \$1,000 for Field Trips, which could average anywhere between \$7.40 to \$9.43 per student, depending on how many students were in each grade level. So at our last PTA General Meeting we voted on and approved the School Field trips to increase to \$10 per student (instead of by grade level). This was a great idea by our Treasurer, Samantha Friesenhahn, and was very well received by the teachers as well.

With spring coming up, we are already looking ahead to our Square One Art project with the students. This is where they create their own artwork in Art Class with Ms. Baker and it is sent home for you to be able to purchase items such as Mouse Pads, magnets, Canvas Bags, Pillow Cases, etc, all with your child's artwork. These make such great Mother's Day gifts and keepsakes.

We also have our 3rd Annual End of Year Carnival which will be on the last day of school again this year. Please see more information in this newsletter from our Carnival Chairperson, Michelle Egli.

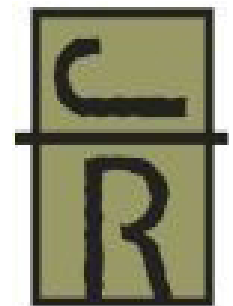
