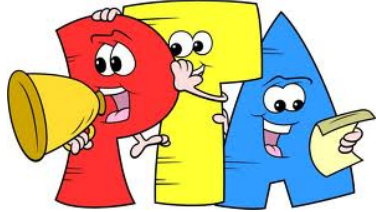


Rahe Bulverde Elementary PTA
