GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS FOR A DIPLOMA AND
PARTICIPATION IN COMMENCEMENT EXERCISES

On June 27, 2007, the Board of Trustees approved a policy requiring that all students must meet all state and local graduation requirements, including all applicable exit-level testing, to be eligible to participate in commencement activities and ceremonies, effective for the 2007–08 school year.

The exit-level test required for students in grade 11 covers English language arts, mathematics, science, and social studies and requires knowledge of Algebra I, Geometry, Biology, Integrated Chemistry and Physics, English III, Early American and United States History, World History and World Geography. A student who does not pass the exit-level assessment will have additional opportunities to take the test.

I understand the above requirements in order to receive a high school diploma and to participate in commencement exercises.
