3rd Quarter Assurances

- The student will evaluate the impact of the Progressive Era (New Deal) leading to the passage of the 16th and 17th amendment.
- The student will analyze the causes of the Great Depression, including world trade, stock market crash, and bank failures.
- The student will identify reasons for U.S. involvement in World War II, including dictatorships.
- The student will analyze the causes and effects of issues such as Red Scare, Immigration, and the changing role of women.
- The student will explain U.S. mobilized its economy (beyond the depression) and raised American Army.
- The student will describe how the wartime economy created opportunities for women and minorities.
- The student will identify the effects of population growth and distribution as a product of World War II.
- The student will describe the economic effects of World War II on the home front, including rationing, female employment and the end of the Great Depression.
- The student will analyze reasons for Western victory in the Cold War and change in relationships among nations.
- The student will identify effects of Cold War to current major domestic and foreign issues.
- The student will identify changes in U.S. as result of civil rights movements such as; increase participation in political processes by minorities.
- The student will analyze effects of changing demographic patterns resulting form migration from within the U.S.
- The student will evaluate various means of achieving equality of political rights including the 19th, 24th, and 26th amendments.
